

The Singapore FinTech Festival (SFF) is the **world's largest and most influential global gathering of the policy, finance, and technology ecosystem**, convening over **65,000 attendees from more than 130 countries**. Taking place in Singapore on its 60th year of independence, this year marks a significant milestone: the 10th edition of the Festival.
